Please do not touch the artwork.

### Sketching and Photography

Visitors may not use pens, video cameras, or selfie sticks in the galleries. Still photography is permitted without flash and tripod and for noncommercial use only. Visit the Lobby desk for the Museum's policy on gallery sketching and photography.

### Strollers

Strollers are permitted in most areas. Inquire with a staff member for gallery limitations. Oversize and jogging strollers may not be brought into the Museum.

### Food and Drink

Water in plastic bottles may be brought into the Museum. Other food or drink is not allowed and may not be checked at the coat checks.

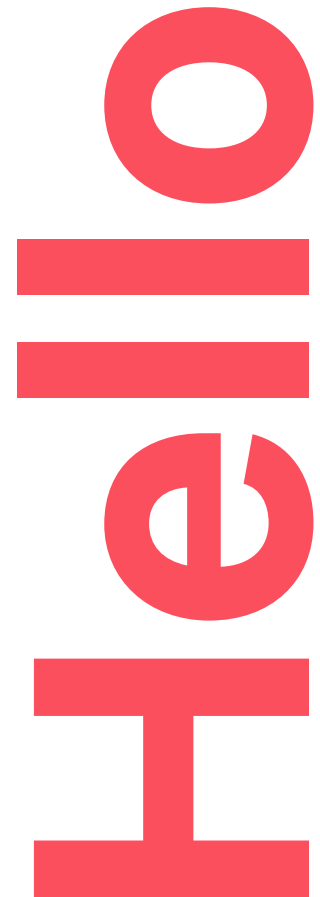
