

Directions

The Met Cloisters is located in Fort Tryon Park in northern Manhattan. Free parking is available in Fort Tryon Park around The Met Cloisters.

Bus

The M4 bus route begins near Penn Station, runs north on Madison Avenue and continues to The Met Cloisters (last stop). Please allow for more time when traveling by bus.

Subway

Take the uptown A train to 190th Street Station. Exit the station by elevator to Fort Washington Avenue and either walk along the designated route through the park, or take the M4 bus one stop to The Met Cloisters (free transfer with the use of a MetroCard).

Driving from the south via Broadway

Turn left onto 181st Street. Turn right onto Fort Washington Avenue and continue to Fort Tryon Park. Follow the designated route through the park to The Met Cloisters.

Driving from the east via the Cross Bronx Expressway

Take the 181st Street exit (last in New York). Follow 181st Street and turn left onto Fort Washington Avenue. Continue on Fort Washington Avenue to Fort Tryon Park. Follow the designated route through the park to The Met Cloisters.

Driving from the north via Broadway

Turn right onto 181st Street. Turn right onto Fort Washington Avenue and continue to Fort Tryon Park. Follow the designated route through the park to The Met Cloisters.

Driving from New Jersey via the George Washington Bridge, by bus

Exit onto 178th Street. Turn left onto Broadway, then turn left onto 181st Street. Turn right onto Fort Washington Avenue and continue to Fort Tryon Park. Follow the designated route through the park to The Met Cloisters.

Driving from New Jersey via the George Washington Bridge, by car

Take the Henry Hudson Parkway (north) to Exit 16, marked "Fort Tryon Park, The Cloisters," approximately one mile north of the George Washington Bridge.
