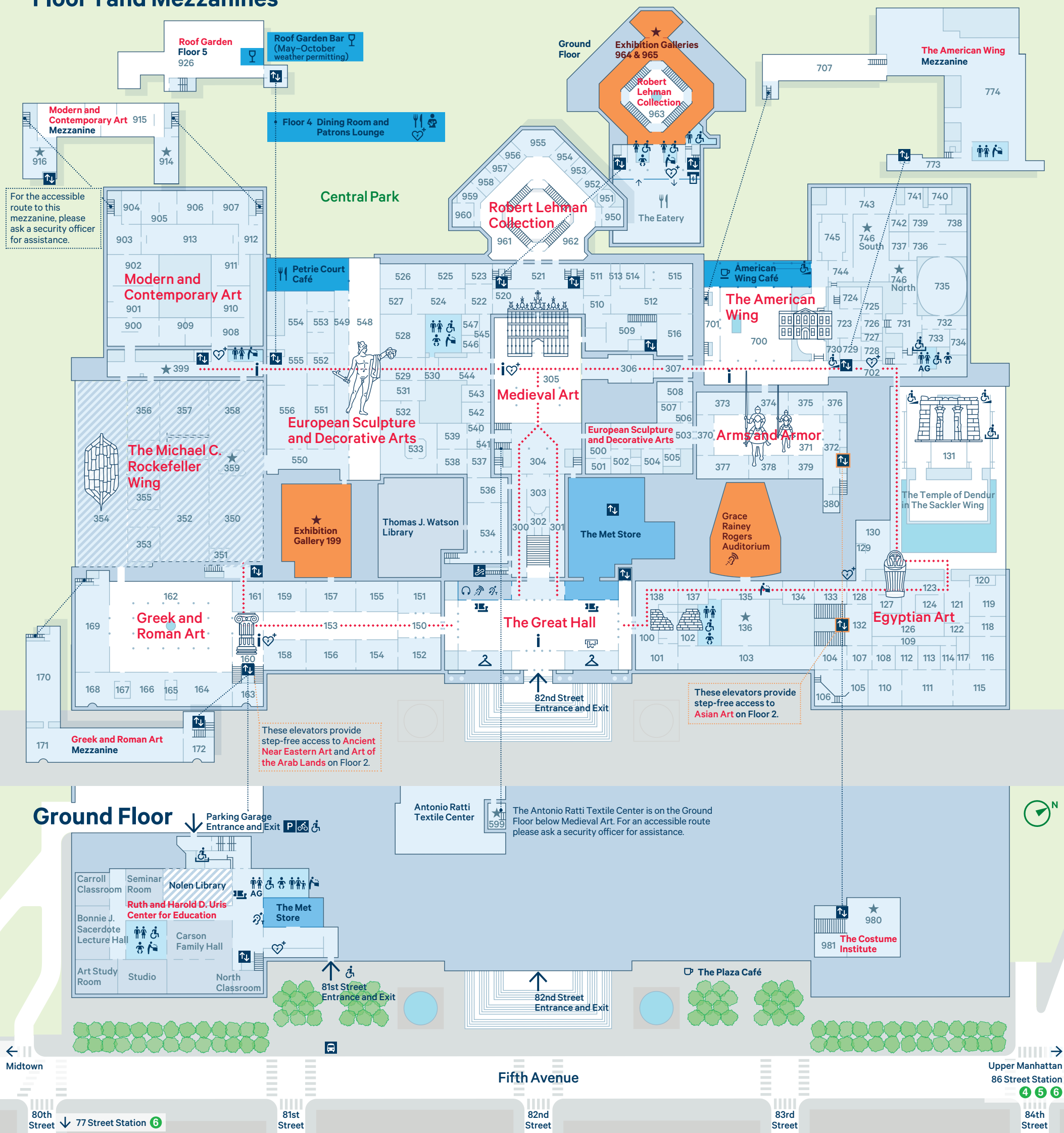
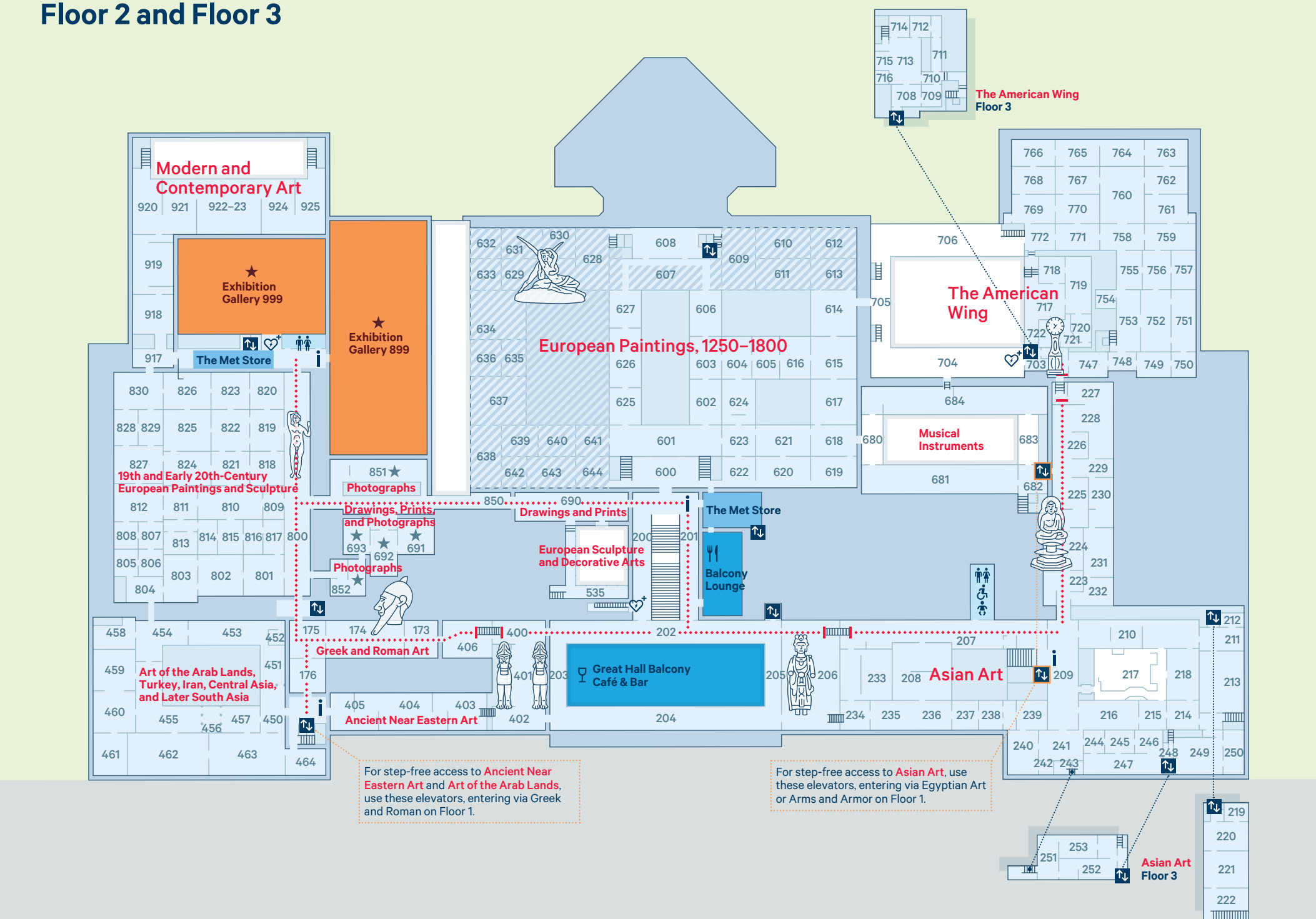


Floor 1 and Mezzanines
